Pet named _____ hereby enter into the following agreement:

In consideration of Lakefield Veterinary Group caring for and providing services for your pet at Doggy Day Camp, owner agrees to adhere to the following terms and conditions:

AGE: All dogs must be five (5) months of age or older.

SEX: All dogs must be spayed or neutered.

SHOTS: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owner must submit written proof that their dogs are current with their Rabies, DHLPP*vaccinations and have received a Bordetella vaccination between the last 7 days to 12months.

*Specifically the vaccines required are Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus and Bordetella. These shots are more commonly referred to as DHLPP; 5 in 1.

FECAL: Owners must submit written proof of a clear fecal examination- tested within the past 12 months. New, clear fecal examinations must be submitted annually.

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will need to certify that their dogs(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Owners have an ongoing duty, while their pet is in attendance at Lakefield Veterinary Group, to insure their pet is in good health. On admission, all dogs must be free from any condition with could potentially jeopardize other campers. Dogs who have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted. Dogs exhibiting any sign of potential, communicable disease may be removed from Camp until certified in good health by a veterinarian.

BEHAVIOR: All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will need to certify , on an ongoing basis, while his/her pet is in attendance at Lakefield Veterinary Group, that their dog(s) have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior toward any person or any other dog(s). Please remember that your pet will be spending time with other pets and that their safety and health is our main concern. Lakefield Veterinary Group reserves the right to remove/disqualify any dog from camp that exhibits any form off aggression.

APPLICATION: All campers must have a complete, up-to-date and approved application on file.

PRICING: Lakefield Veterinary Group will provide owner with current package pricing. Prices are subject to change.

DAYS AND HOURS: Your dog may be at Lakefield Veterinary Group, Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. or be left after 7:00p.m. During those times, he/she will spend several hours in the camp room with other campers. Each day, every camper may also be assigned a private suite in Doggy Village where he/she will rest in the comfort of his/her own space, when not in the camp room. Snacks can be served during the suite time, at your request

Doggy Day Camp is not an overnight program. Your pet may not be dropped off before 7:00 a.m. or left after 7:00p.m. Pets remaining after 7:00 p.m. will be transferred to the boarding area and kept overnight. Customers will be charged the regular boarding rate in addition to the Camp charge for dogs left overnight.

RESERVATIONS: Pre-registration and payment is recommended and may be required at peak times including, but not limited to our 'party' days when space is limited.

Lakefield Veterinary Group reserves the right to rescind the spot reserved for an owner's pet at its discretion if owner fails to comply with any of the rules, regulations, or fee provisions outlined above.

B. Responsibilities of Owner of Dog and Rights of Lakefield Veterinary Group

1. Lakefield Veterinary Group has taken reasonable steps to minimize the occurrence of airborne illness including but not limited to canine influenza virus and tracheobronchitis ("canine cough"). However, no amount of supervision, sanitation or personalized care can prevent a pet from contracting an airborne virus. Owner(s) agrees that Lakefield Veterinary Group will not in any way be responsible or liable for any injuries, harm, damages, losses of any type whatsoever caused by airborne virus.

2. Because Day Camp is a group play environment with close pet to pet interaction, injuries may occur during play. Owner(s) agrees that Lakefield Veterinary Group will not in any way be responsible or liable for any injuries, harm, damages or losses of any type whatsoever sustained by owner's pet or any of owner's property.

3. Healthy Pet Plan coverage is not available for pets participating in camp. Healthy Pet Plan coverage purchased for boarding pets does not extend to Camp. Any illness or injury sustained by boarders while participating in Camp would not be covered under the Healthy Pet Plan.

4. Owner(s) hereby agrees that he/she is responsible for all injuries, harm, damages and losses of any type caused by owner or his/her pet. Owner further agrees to allow Lakefield Veterinary Group to release owner(s) contact information to owner of pet suffering injury or harm from owner(s) pet.

5. Further owner(s) agrees to indemnify and hold Lakefield Veterinary Group, its officers, agents and employees harmless from any and all claims or lawsuits of any type arising out of owner and his/her pet's conduct and to be solely responsible for all payment of any type, including costs, legal fees or payments of any type Lakefield Veterinary Group might incur, that may become due because of the conduct of owner(s) or his/her pet, even if Lakefield Veterinary Group is wholly or partly negligent in away.

6. Owner(s) further agrees that Lakefield Veterinary Group will not in any way be responsible for liable for Any injuries, harm, damages, losses of any type whatsoever sustainable by owner, owner's pet or any of owner's property.

7. Further, owner expressly waives his/her right to pursue any claims or lawsuits of any type against Lakefield Veterinary Group, and expressly releases Lakefield Veterinary Group from any and all responsibility and liability of any type it may have for all injuries, harm, losses, or damages owner, owner's pet or owner's property may sustain while at Lakefield Veterinary Group, even if such injuries, harm, losses or damages caused, in whole or in part, due to negligence or lack of proper care of Lakefield Veterinary Group or its officers, agents or employees.

8. I expressly authorize Lakefield Veterinary Group to release my personal information and that of my pet or other property, at the discretion of Lakefield Veterinary Group, to anyone requiring the information as a result of damage/injury cause by my pet.

9. I further understand and that in admitting my dog(S) to the Day Camp, Lakefield Veterinary Group has relied on my representation that my dog(s) is/are in good health and have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other pet.

10. I further understand and agree that any problem that may develop with my dog(s) will be handled at the sole discretion of Lakefield Veterinary Group staff. By signing this agreement, I grant my permission for emergency necessary veterinary care at the discretion of the veterinarian appointed by Lakefield Veterinary Group Pet Care, Inc. and I agree to assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved. In non-emergencies, Lakefield Veterinary Group will first obtain the consent of owner prior to providing veterinarian care for owner's pet. If owner consents to such treatment, he/she shall assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses required.

11. I further understand that Lakefield Veterinary Group Doggy Day Camp Program was designed by Best Friend's nationally recognized experts in canine group behavior. They planned schedules and activities, based on the most current research in canine behavior and welfare. As knowledge of the field grows, Lakefield Veterinary Group reserves the right to revise the camp agenda for the good of the group as a whole for the welfare of a specific camper.

I certify that I have carefully read and understand the rules, regulations and fees set forth on the preceding pages and that I have fully read and understand this agreement and any terms I did not understand, have been sufficiently explained to me, I agree to abide the rules, regulations and fees and accept all the terms, conditions, and statements of this agreement.
